Located on the existing Kaseman Hospital Campus on Constitution, this state-of-the-art medical office building consolidates 50 PMG primary care and specialty care practitioners.

Architectural features were designed into the existing hospital and new emergency department drop-off to tie all buildings together. Wood and stone accents were used in the common areas to give a "homey" feel inside. Stone was also used extensively on the building's exterior. The same stone will be incorporated into the facade of the more than 30-year-old Kaseman Hospital to tie the two buildings together.

The building also includes an interior open courtyard to bring natural light into the interior of the building, with primary care physicians on the first floor and specialists on the second. There will be a convenient drop-off area and no curbs. In dealing with an aging population, making access to the building as user-friendly as possible is essential to the hospital goals.
